## Notice of Penalty and Interest Relief for IFTA Regarding COVID-19 April 21, 2020

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Illinois Department of Revenue (IDOR) is waiving penalty and interest through May 26, 2020 on late-filed, first quarter International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) returns due April 30, 2020. To take advantage of this waiver, file your first quarter 2020 IFTA return electronically by May 26, 2020. Beginning May 27, 2020, penalty and interest will be calculated from the original due date of April 30, 2020 on those returns not yet filed.

In addition to Illinois, interest due under IFTA is also being waived in 48 of 58 U.S. and Canadian jurisdictions. Please note, however, interest remains due on late-filed returns beginning May 1, 2020 in the following jurisdictions:

Alabama	New Jersey
Georgia	New York
Louisiana	North Carolina
Michigan	Nova Scotia
Minnesota	Rhode Island

IDOR recommends you file and pay timely any liability due by April 30, 2020 to avoid paying interest to the jurisdictions listed above.
