



**What are Enterprise Zones?**

**Enterprise zones** are economically distressed areas in Illinois that qualify for special tax incentives once they are designated by the state and participating local governments. The following portions of the municipalities and counties listed are designated as enterprise zones. For more information, please contact the local zone administrator.

**What are Foreign or "Free" Trade Zones or Sub-Zones?**

**Foreign or "free" trade zones or sub-zones** are secured areas legally outside a nation's customs territory. In Illinois, foreign trade zones are located in portions of Chicago, Granite City, Peoria, Rock Island, Moline, Lawrence Co., Rockford, Decatur, and Jo Daviess and Carroll Counties.
